Book Club Discussion Questions for *Angels of the Resistance*

- **Motivation and Transformation:** Lien is motivated to join the resistance following Madi's death. How does this personal tragedy shape her actions and risk-taking behavior throughout the novel?
- **Sisterly Dynamics:** How do the relationship dynamics between the sisters shift as they become deeper entrenched in dangerous, high-stakes resistance activities?
- **The Morality of War:** The characters are tasked with seducing, killing, and sabotage. How does the author tackle the moral gray areas the sisters must navigate?
- **Character Development:** Which characters did you find yourself rooting for the most, and which character's choices surprised you the most?
- **Bravery vs. Recklessness:** Was Lien's tenacity and pursuit of dangerous assignments brave or foolish, given the stakes?
- **The Cost of Love:** Emotional attachments are described as a liability in the book. Discuss how Lien's connection with Charlie complicates her mission and her survival.
- **Personal Mission vs. Greater Good:** How does the "deeply personal mission" mentioned in the synopsis jeopardize not only the sisters' lives but also the work of their unit?
- **Realism of the Resistance:** What new insights did you gain about the Dutch Resistance and the specific, undercover roles women played in it?
- **The Ending:** What did you think of the conclusion? Did the characters find the redemption or peace they were looking for?
- **Symbolism of the Title:** Why do you think the author titled the book *Angels of the Resistance*? How does this phrase relate to the characters' roles as "wolves in sheep's clothing"?
