On November 10, 1975, the SS Edmund Fitzgerald sank in Lake Superior during a violent storm, claiming the lives of all 29 crew members.

The ship disappeared suddenly without sending a distress signal. Investigations suggested possible causes such as wave overtopping and hull damage.

The tragedy led to major safety reforms, including improved hatch standards, mandatory distress beacons, and better communication protocols.
